Discover if You Have a Legitimate Slip & Fall Case

- Was the property where you were injured in an unsafe condition?

- Would any reasonable person caring for this property have known or should have known that there was a potential hazard?
- If an object (such as loose carpet or underground plumbing) was involved, do you believe that there was a safer place that object could have been placed?
- Did your injury occur within the past 30 days?
- Did the property owner have a reasonable amount of time to fix the hazardous condition after becoming aware of it?
- Were you being careful?
